





Action Taken Report 2016-17

The feedback from Students, Teachers, Alumni and Employers were taken, and findings of the feedback were systematically analyzed by the IQAC

Analysis of detailed feedback brought forth the finding, which were informative and on certain attributes revealing. The IQAC in consultation with the Deans of faculties and Head of departments undertook the following actions:

- 1. Books for Library were procured, leading to an increase in volume and number of titles
- 2. Books under the reference category were also procured for library
- 3. Extra lectures were organized faculty/department wise on the basis of subjects/topics categorized as 'Hard' by slow learners
- 4. Revision Lectures/sessions were organized after the completion of syllabus by faculty members
- 5. The frequency of in class evaluation of students was increased to assess the effectiveness and efficacy of curriculum transaction
- 6. Departments were instructed to provide study material/course hand-outs and also previous year university question papers were placed in the Central Library/Department Library
- 7. Faculty members delegated in-class individual/group projects to strengthen the teaching learning process in pragmatic terms
- 8. Quality research publications have been placed in department libraries for the benefit of students/research scholars
- 9. Mentor Mentee system has been strengthened to ensure meaningful and comprehensive development of students
- 10. Personal and career counseling sessions have been made part of Teacher Students interaction beyond class-room teaching
- 11. On the basis of the findings of the employers' feedback, special focus has been given on developing communication skill of students, particularly formal communication in English
- 12. Development of public speaking skill of students is being due importance, and Thought Spectrum platform is being used for development of students
