I. The above meeting, as notified (Appendix-2) by No. even Dt. 21.08.20 was held on 25th Aug 2020 (Tuesday), 1 PM onwards at Research Centre Shashi Campus Kotwa on the subject specified as above in which members of IQAC and Ph.D Supervisors of NGBDU (Appendix-1) attended the same.

II. To Start with, Member Convener (IQAC) extended heart felt welcome to Prof. R. M. Pathak; the newly appointed Vice-Chancellor, Pro-V C Dr. S.C.Tiwari, all the members of IQAC, faculty colleague members who could attend this meeting during COVID-19.

Prof. R.C. Tripathi presented Ann-2 -IQAC Plan 2019-20 read with status as on 25-08-2020. This was discussed. It was noted that majority of the points were held up due to COVID-19 and will be taken up during current year 2020-21. The IQAC Annual Plan 2020-21 is now accordingly finalized as Appendix-3.

It was also emphasized that Quality in any product or service is build-in by the person manufacturing the product or executing the service and his/her entire team. It cannot be overlaid by the Seniors as such. Therefore, It is expedient that all of us strive our best and make 'IQAC' as mirror of accomplishments of the NGBDU in totality. 2/1/12- Strength of girl/lady student will be promoted to touch about 48% of total students, for 15% in faculty plus 2 women as institute HOD's/Course Co-ordinator or in the Administration for the management of the University.

2/1/13- Action will start for work places in the University to be user friendly for DIVYANGS in terms of (i) Ramps, Lifts, Walking aids etc. (ii) Disabled friendly toilets (iii) Audio visual Aids.

2/1/14- Peer Rating (PR) is to be initiated for survey to be conducted by a large number of reputed academicians, institution heads, HR heads of employees, members of funding agencies in Govt/Private Sector/NGO etc. Webinar List of experts may be considered.

- 2- Dr. R K Tiwari CoE:- He will provide total no. of examinees, total number of courses examined ONLINE etc.
- 3- Sh. S S Mishra Dir.(Spl. Edu)--: Effort of S.S.Mishra for campus activities ITisation were taken on record. All the teachers were requested to maintain and submit in SSR the details of their Lectures already recorded.
- 4- Dean (Commerce) with Sh S. S. Mishra will evolve said guideline and provide the same to Member Convener (IQAC) for uposting the same in ATR. of Minutes of Current IQAC Meeting.
- 5- Effort of Prof. R. C. Tripathi in Conducting On-line Course to 77 Ph.D students (CRET-19) with full transparency and record keeping was applauded.
- 6- Prof. K. K. Tiwari Dean(Edu)-was requested to store and maintain hard copy of all project reports/ assignments evaluated online by his department.
- 7- Computerised Admission System will include record of all offline fee received concurrently.
- 8- Organizing E-conferences should start in year 2020-21 by Dr. Asheesh Shivam and Dr. R C Mishra
- 9- Dr. R. P. Ojha Informed that online examination of 77 CRET-19 Students, 4 Ph.D Final Viva-Voce, 1 PSP and 3 Research fellowship up gradation cases were organised in ONLINE mode since 16th July- 2020 by his Centre.
- 10- The List of 50 Webinars Organized ONLINE associating 67 experts during COVID-19 by NGBU was appreciated. It was decided that their proceeding benefitting the rural youths of the entire country in Hard and Soft copies at newly to be established Data Centre be maintained as Library Archival

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11- Shri S. S. Mishra Informed that several internal meetings were held to submit IQA presently withheld, and will be submitted whereafter SSR will be finalised.
